### GENERAL INFO for K-6th

- **Time:** 9am-Noon (please arrive a few minutes early to get checked in).
- **Opening:** Begins promptly at 9 with kid friendly Praise & Worship, & Bible teaching.
- **Tye-Dye:** On Monday all the campers will participate in a group art project where they will make their own camp T-shirt.
- **K-2nd:** Our youngest campers will rotate thru stations which will include Bible Memory, Music, Bible Story, Praying Color (Journaling), Snack, Games & Art.
- **3rd-6th** will attend Praying in Color and then two Elective Classes they chose. A snack will be provided during this time.
- **Friday Lunch & Tour:** On Friday we invite you to attend a Lunch for the campers & parents from 12pm-1pm. Enjoy a bite to eat, & then visit your child's classrooms to see the projects that they made or the skills they have learned. This is a non-structured time so that parents & campers can leave when they need to. All projects will be available to take home on Friday.
- **Attendance:** It is important that campers attend all five days.
- **Security:** For security purposes we ask that you do not drop your child off at the door but come in and sign your child into camp EVERY morning. All camp staffers are in green shirts which say volunteer.
- **What to bring to camp:** Your happy, smiling face, a water bottle with your name on it! Some elective classes require campers to bring certain things to class so, be sure to read the class information carefully. No electronics please!
- **PARENTS OF THE OH Preschool & Childcare Center:** It is important that you complete the Arts Camp on the Hill registration form even though the childcare center has your info. Since the camp is organized by the church it is necessary for us to have this form completed. Also, if your child normally does not attend the center every day of the week please consider having them come to camp on their days off.

### IMPORTANT INFO FOR GRADES 3-6

\*Every Elective Class is held twice a day for 5 days. Class sizes are different depending upon the type of class it is. Please get your registration in early.

\*Friends/Buddy's-If your child wants to take the same classes with a friend please indicate that on the form AND make sure the friend turns in their registration in a timely fashion. Once the maximum students per class is reached we can not switch things around. Every attempt is made to accommodate these requests when they are made early enough.

\*Campers are assigned to classes on a first-come-first-serve basis based on their 1st & 2nd choices. Please turn in your registration early!

\*Alternate Classes will be assigned when (1) A class is filled and/or (2) A child's schedule will not permit them to be in both their 1st & 2nd choices. Choose your alternate class carefully! If this happens we try to communicate it to the parents prior to the first day of camp. Email is the best way to do this so PLEASE share it with us on the form.

### ELECTIVE CLASS SELECTION FOR 3RD-6TH GRADE ONLY!

**GRAFFITI ART**-Creative fun course using aerosols, markers, stencils & canvases. Learn the fundamentals of art through graffiti perspective, color & character design & work on a group project.

**VOCAL MUSIC/SONGWRITING**- Explore vocal techniques and exercises that will help students learn the arts of singing. Stage presence, microphone skills, and lyrical expression for polishing performances along with tools for writing your own song!

**PRINTING CLASS**-Come & discover the world of printing. We will look at different kinds of printing from sign & T-shirt printing to carvings for printing. Discover how much fun ink & your imagination can be.

**PERCUSSION**-Discover rhythmic patterns as you learn to make music through stomping, pounding, & striking lids, buckets, & other commonly found items.

**DRAMA**-Explore your dramatic side through a variety of theater games, improvisations, and short scenes.

**ART OF INVENTION**-If you enjoy creating & inventing, this is for you! You'll be spending this time discovering, & thinking in new ways. If the words & thoughts up above flip around in your mind, then join us for a new kind of class.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**-Students will learn special skills for taking digital photographs to compose their own works of art with a creative edge. (Must bring your own digital camera and EMPTY SD card for picture download).

**WOODWORKING**-Students will explore different aspects of woodworking: selecting wood, measuring, marking, determining size & shape, drafting, cutting, drilling, gluing, nailing, sanding, & finishing. Limited to 8 students per class.

**PAPER CRAFTS**-Create your own paper crafts from personal cards that you can send to friends to book marks you can use in school.

**INTERPRETIVE DANCE**-Learn to express the meaning behind song lyrics through creative movement & dance as a means to worship.

**LURE MAKING**-This creative art is for those who love fishing. In this class you will learn the art of making your own lures by reproducing the bugs of nature. Then on the last day, we will try out our creations by going fishing.

**PAINTING & CHALK ART**-Use your creativity on paper using a variety of different paint, brush, & chalk materials. Students will learn techniques like perspective, composition, & drawing methods that will help them create colorful art that shows their individuality & personality.
